Lawrence: After Arabia is a historical drama, which tells the story of the last years of the life of T.E. Lawrence - Lawrence of Arabia. In the early 1930s Lawrence centred his life at his cottage at Cloud's Hill in Dorset. From this time Lawrence of Arabia spent the rest of his life escaping the epithet of hero.

While he had influential friends his uncompromising manner created powerful enemies. He continued to be involved in the Arab cause and created links to Mosely and the Blackshirts. Lawrence's friend Churchill also planned for him to lead the Secret Service. Zionists, Secret Service and the establishment were all against him.

In May 1935 Lawrence was involved in a motorcycle accident. With his enemies gathering it may have been an assassination engineered by the British Secret Service. He died a few days later.

Chronologically this feature film follows on from David Lean's "Lawrence of Arabia" (1962) with Peter O'Toole playing Lawrence and "Dangerous Man: Lawrence After Arabia" (1990) with Ralph Fiennes who played the title role.

With a solid screenplay and initial investment pre-production has begun with cast, crew and locations being chosen. The rest of the budget is to be raised by "angels" - film lovers who want to be part of movie making history. In exchange for a small investment sponsors will be credited as Associate Producers, appear as an extra or watch filming. We will also seek corporate sponsors. It is planned to start filming in June 2019 with film release in May 2020.
